

New Patient Policy

Required Information

On your first visit please bring the following information:

- Any current X-rays that were taken by a previous dentist. Digital X-rays can be
 emailed to our office from your previous dentist upon request. Previous X-rays
 should be dated and of diagnostic quality. If the images are unclear, we may have to
 take additional X-rays at your appointment. Our email address is
 <u>TyeFamilyDentistry@securedds.com</u>. This is a secure email, so your personal
 information will not be compromised.
- A list of medications you are currently taking
- Any current medical concerns or conditions
- A valid photo ID or driver's license (parent or guardian if under 18 years old)
- If covered by dental insurance, an insurance card including the name of the subscriber, subscriber's date of birth, member ID or social security number, and the subscriber's employer.
- Completed new patient forms that can be accessed on our website,
 TyeFamilyDentistry.com. If all forms are not completed prior to your visit, we ask you to arrive 15 minutes early to your scheduled appointment time.

Insurance Verification

Prior to your appointment, our billing staff will verify your insurance coverage so they can give you an estimate of co-pays, fees, etc. As a courtesy, we will send your claims electronically to your insurance company even if our office is out-of-network. Reimbursement varies depending on the insurance company, policy, and network status. We do our best to inform you prior to treatment what your cost and or copay will be.

Patients that are under the age of 18

Patients that are under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Patients that are over the age of 18 are considered responsible for all charges to their account on the date of service, even if they are a dependent on the insurance policy.
